**COOPERATION AGREEMENT CROWNED BY INTERNATIONAL PROJECT SUCCESS**

International project „European Day of Integrated Sport“ presentation of the results was the official beginning of cooperation between the Kauno Kolegija/ University of Applied Sciences and Lithuanian Sport Federation for the Disabled. Heads of institutions – director of Kauno Kolegija/ University of Applied Sciences Dr. Mindaugas Misiūnas and president of Lithuanian Sport Federation for the Disabled Anatolijus Čupkovas – on October 15 signed a cooperation agreement to further successful cooperation.

Cooperation purposefully started consolidate when 9 students of Sport Management Department together with Lithuanian Sport Federation for the Disabled representatives in Italy participated in the international project „European Day of Integrated Sport“. The project is organized by the Italian sports organization „Centro Sportivo Educativo Nazionale“. „The aim of project is to involve disable and able-bodied athletes in great day of integrated sport and promote tolerance,“ – said the technical coordinator of the project in Lithuania Jurate Martinonytė.

The competitions are run according to the rules. This allows all 16 participating organizations (coming from 13 European countries) to test out the rules being adopted and to cheer when they win.

„Cooperation Agreement signing day was to introduce the participants to achieve results and Specificity of integrated sports, which we will try to adapt in Lithuania“ – draws plans for the future Head of Sport Management Department and national coordinator Dr. Andrius Brusokas.
